**Eligibility Conditions:**

- (i) Employee who has retired from Government Service on attaining the age of superannuation and below the age of sixty five years having good service records and are physically fit shall be eligible to be considered for re-employment.
- (ii) Officers against whom departmental proceedings or criminal cases are contemplated/pending or who have been penalized for misconduct during the period of preceding five years will not be eligible for consideration.

**Terms and Conditions :**

- (i) Re-employed employee shall be governed by the provisions of Odisha Government Servants Conduct Rules 1959 and shall be liable to be proceeded against for his/her misconduct, omissions and commissions as per the provisions under the Odisha Pension Rules 1992.
