



Sir,

With reference to the subject cited above, I am to inform you that there is a target for establishment of 4 nos Common Hiring Centre (CHC) in Nuapada District ( 1 each in Nuapada/Komna/Khariar & Sinapali block) under IAP (Cotton) State Plan Scheme The Motto of the Establishment of Custom Hiring Centers (CHCs) is to strengthen the CBOs (SHGs) etc. Custom Hiring Centre shall be nearer to Cotton clusters / near the cotton cropping area. Special focus is to be given for those implements highly needed for the cotton cultivation, implements which will reduce drudgery and encourage women to take up cotton cultivation, implement which have high demand locally, list of people who are willing to become member of CHCs , items to be purchased shall be finalized by the CBO in consultation with AAO/BAO.

The indicative items for implements to cover the Cotton crop are as follows.

- i) Self propelled Power Weeder (up to 2-5 hp)
- ii) Power Sprayer.
- iii) Pump sets
- iv) Manual Implements like Cotton bund Ridger with beam, cycle weeder.
- v) Cotton Plucking machine.
- vi) HDPE pipes for carrying water from source to field.
- vii) Any other need based equipment / implements with approval of CDAO-cum-PD, ATMA or the DA&FP(O) BBSR.

There is provision for financial assistance of Rs.2, 00,000/- for establishment of n 1 CHC. The cost over & above this will be borne by the concerned WSHGs,

In this context, you are requested to float an EoI in the district website for establishment of CHC by the interested SHGs.







**Modalities for the supply of Agriculture implements/ equipments for Establishment of Custom Hiring Centres through WSHGs under the Scheme "Intensive Agriculture Programme (Cotton Sector) for Revival & Sustainable Intensification of Forgotten Crops" -State Plan -2023-24 (Supply of set of Agril. Implements)**

There is provision for the supply of 38 sets of machineries/ implements to the Cotton growing districts. The implements which reduces drudgery, encourage women to take up cultivation, implements which have high demand locally, reduces cost of cultivation, timely intercultural operations are included under the Scheme.

Pool of Agril. Implements for Cotton crop - CHCs.

1. Tractor operated MB Plough / Disc harrow -1 Nos.
2. Rotavator- 1 Nos.
3. Multicrop Planter (Tractor operated) – 1 nos.
4. Self propelled (Petrol operated) Power Weeder Upto 5 hp – 1 nos.
5. Power Sprayer-2 Nos.
6. Petrol/ Kerosene Pumpset upto 2 hp- 1 Nos.
7. HDPE Conveyance pipe (4 Kg/ Sq.cm) @ 6mt per No. - 10 Nos.
8. Cotton bund Ridger with beam (Bullock Drawn) - 5 Nos.
9. Cycle Weeder (Manual) - 5 Nos.

***N.B. : The list of machines is indicative, the proposed CHC have to select set of implements whose total cost should be more than Rs.2,00,000/-.***

**1.Name of the activity-**

Establishment of Custom Hiring Centre through CBOs (SHGs etc.)

**Total unit cost:** Rs.2,00,000/-

**Financial assistance to WSHGs under the activity:**

An amount of Rs.2.00 lakh of the cost of selected set of Agril. Implements will be borne under the said Scheme. The cost over & above this will be borne by the concerned WSHGs.

**2. Procedure for selection of WSHGs under the said activity:**

Guideline for selection of WSHGs for different activities vide Memo No. 24761/ A & FE

Dt.09.12.2021 will be followed for engagement of WSHGs.

1. The district-wise target has already been communicated to the CDAOs of Cotton growing districts. The list of WSHGs will be selected by the concerned CDAOs in consultation with the district level officials of Mission Shakti taking into consideration of those who are involved in agricultural activities of the Cotton growing districts/ blocks.
2. The final list of selected WSHG will be submitted to the DA & FP (O) for facilitating the supply of set of implements. Each eligible WSHG will be supplied with 1 unit of set of implements. The amount over and above the provisioned Rs. 2.0 Lakhs will be borne by the concerned WSHG.
3. The **District level Committee** constituting CDAO, Concerned EE (Agril.), Scheme Officer, KVK Scientists, BAO/ AAO, President/Secretary and one member from WSHG will finalise the set of implements required as per feasibility for that particular SHG.
4. The Make & models of the selected set of machineries will be finalised by the respective WSHG and submit in writing along with depositing the differential amount exceeding Rs.2,00,000/- with the CDAO.
5. The CDAO will place the destination-wise indent to MD, OAIC for supply of the SLTC approved set of Agril. Machineries of Manufacturers/farms having valid Service Level Agreement (SLA). For Manual & Bullock drawn implements OAIC will supply from the registered SSI units.
6. The OAIC will supply within 15 days from the date of indent given by the CDAO at the designated destination of concerned WSHGs and give demonstration for use of the set of implements.
7. The concerned BAO/ AAO & AAE will verify the supplied set of machineries its condition in presence of DM, OAIC. A joint verification report will be submitted to the CDAO regarding proper functioning of the supplied implements.
8. After submission of Joint verification Report, payment will be released to the MD, OAIC within 7 days by respective CDAO from the funds (@Rs.2,00,000) placed for the purpose by DA & FP (O) along with the differential amount deposited by concerned WSHG. The concerned AAO/ BAO will visit the site on regular basis to monitor the performance for better utilisation of the machineries by the WSHGs , submit a fortnightly progress report and furnish the **success stories** after first season for enumeration of the performance under the Scheme **"Intensive Agriculture Programme(Cotton Sector) for Revival & Sustainable Intensification of Forgotten Crops" -State Plan -2023-24 (Supply of set of Agril. Implements).**
